Did you know....?

Finger size is NOT the same as knuckle size....

Since a ring has to be large enough to pass over your knuckle first, it is often too large for the base of your finger and will roll or turn when worn. This can damage both the ring and the exquisite gem stones you cherish. Finger sizes change with the weather. The time of day. Physical activity. And the seasons. The ring that fits wonderfully in the winter may suddenly become too tight in the summer. Or when you work out. (Hot, perspiring fingers can expand up to 2 sizes). Stress, medications, pregnancy, hormonal changes, arthritis, weight loss or weight gain, injury, etc. also affect the size of your finger and the way your ring fits.
